PTE Home A1, A2 & B1 Tests

Everything You Need to Know

If you are planning to move to the UK, extend your stay, apply for settlement, or bring your family members, you will most likely need to prove your English language ability. One of the most trusted options for this is the **PTE Home test**.

Many students feel confused about which level to choose, what the test includes, and how difficult it really is. In this article, we'll explain PTE Home A1, A2, and B1 in a clear and simple way so you can decide confidently.

? What is the PTE Home Test?

PTE Home is an English language test approved by the UK Home Office for visa and immigration purposes. Unlike academic English exams, this test focuses only on real-life communication.

The test checks Speaking and Listening skills only. There is no reading or writing, which makes it easier for candidates who struggle with long texts or grammar-heavy tasks.

PTE Home is computer-based and taken at an approved test centre.



Test Format and Duration

- **PTE Home A1:** Around 22 minutes
- **PTE Home A2:** Around 25 minutes
- **PTE Home B1:** Around 29 minutes



PTE Home A1

This is the basic level



- First-time spouse or partner visas
- Dependent or family route visas



PTE Home A2

It is mainly used for



- Visa extensions after living in the UK for some time.



PTE Home B1

It is the highest level of PTE Home.



- Indefinite Level to Remain (ILR)
- British Citizenship



What Tasks Are in the PTE Home Test?

- **Repeat Sentence:** You listen to a sentence and repeat it exactly
- **Describe an Image:** You describe what you see in simple words
- **Answer Short Questions :** Based on what you hear
- **Retell a Story** (mainly in A2 and B1)



Results and Certificate Validity

- Results are usually available within 48 hours
- The result is pass or fail
- The certificate is valid for 2 years

Once you pass, your result can be used directly for your UK visa or settlement application.

PTE Home A1, A2, and B1 tests are designed to be simple, fair, and practical. If you understand which level you need and prepare in the right direction, passing the test is completely achievable. Whether you are applying for a visa, extension, settlement, or citizenship, choosing the correct PTE Home level is the first and most important step
